## GOSPEL ADVANCE 2024

Gospel Advance is how we fund our vision to take Christ Place to Every Place in our Lake Lanier region.

### BUILDING CAMPUSES:

We are one church meeting in three locations. This is the primary way we are taking Christ Place to Every Place. In 2024, we will work to strengthen our campuses while exploring neighborhood groups for the launch of new campuses in the future. This requires a strong commitment to the next generation and training young men and women to be future pastors and campus leaders.

### EXPECTING GOD TO MOVE:

We desire to become a people of prayer and we pray expectantly for God to move. We pray for God to use us to reach the lost in our community. There are 285,000 people that live in our Lake Lanier region. Six out of 10 do not have a relationship with Christ (171,000 lost people). If we are going to reach just 1% of that number this year, then we need to see 2,850 people saved and baptized in 2024. We desperately need God to move!

For us to continue to make Gospel Advance, it will take every family banded together in our missional passion, generous living, leadership development, and relational investments.
